



HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

Teesside Precision Engineering Ltd, regards the achievement of the highest standards in matters of Health & Safety as mutual objectives for the Company and its employees.

- Safe and healthy working conditions are provided and maintained.
- Information on risks to health and safety is provided and that risk assessments are made and control measures implemented.
- Arrangements exist for use, handling, storage, and transportation of articles and substances without risk to health.
- Employees and Sub-contractors are instructed and supervised in safe working practises.
- Equipment, tools, systems of working and access to and egress from workplaces are provided which are safe and without risk to health.
- Consultation and training on Health & Safety measures occurs with its personnel so they are motivated and committed to avoid accidents.
- Adequate first aid facilities, fire fighting equipment, safety devices and protective equipment are provided and their use supervised.
- Accidents are reported, investigated and recorded, and efforts are made to evolve methods of working to avoid or reduce their incidence.

For their part, employees are encouraged and required to:-

- Take reasonable care for the Health & Safety of themselves and other persons who may be affected by their acts or omissions whilst at work.
- Use and respect the safety devices, means of access and egress, and protective equipment provided.
- Co-operate fully with the Company or any other person to enable compliance with statutory duties for Health and Safety.
- Participate in incident and accident investigations, risk assessment, hazard identification and reporting, site safety consultations or meetings, training schemes and other initiatives toward achievement of a safe working environment.
